Please also be aware of the following.

- Adults are asked to:
 - Follow social distancing rules as much as possible.
 - Wear masks/face coverings.
 - Wait outside until the doors are opened at 10am.
 - Confirm verbally that they do not have symptoms of Coronavirus or been in contact with anyone with symptoms.
 - Use the hand sanitiser provided.
 - Sign in for Track and Trace. A Register will be kept.
 - Limit the number of personal belongings brought to the session.
- The kitchen is not currently available for use.
 - If you choose to bring a drink, please ensure hot drinks are in lidded cups for safety.
 - Although we can not provide snacks there will be a snack table identified for children to enjoy snacks brought from home.
- Toilets are available but users are asked to wipe clean any surfaces used/touched with the wipes provided.

The session leader will

- Set up the hall and ensure cleanliness of toys, floor, chairs, door handles and other touch points prior to opening.
- Open windows for ventilation.
- Wear face covering.
- Open the door at 10am to welcome all adults and children.
- Plan and lead activities and a singalong session. (Only 6 adults are currently allowed to sing inside!)
- Keep abreast of Government regulations and act accordingly.
